PROPOSAL TO CHANGE ROAD NAMES

SECTION 58 – LAND ADMINISTRATION ACT 1997

Due to street naming anomalies Council advertised the partial renaming of Blackwood Terrace, Phillips Street and Gifford Road in July 2009. Following public consultation Council has deferred a decision pending additional public advertising in regard to proposed revised changes as follows:

- Central portion of Blackwood Terrace as Riverwalk Terrace instead of Blackwood Terrace West as advertised.
- Eastern section of Blackwood Terrace as Greys Hill up to the intersection with Mattamattup Street with the remainder as Blackwood Terrace instead of Blackwood Terrace East as advertised.
- Central portion of Phillips Street as Mitchell Street instead of Gregory Street as advertised.
- Southern portion of Gifford Road as Austin Dale instead of Austin Court as advertised.
- Davidson Street as an extension of Phillips Street (additional change).
